GAMES

• 4 games guaranteed with opening ceremony and team intro on the first night of the tournament

- 15 minute stop time periods
- Each team should have 2 sets of jerseys with the home team wearing their light color

CHECK IN

- All teams must present their Team Roster prior to the first game.
- Coaches must initial the score sheet prior to each game
- Locker room keys will be available from the rink office. Locker rooms must be cleaned before keys are returned

TROPHIES

• Tournament trophies for 1st and 2nd place teams. Medals for 1st and 2nd place teams.

TEAM SELECTION

- Team registration, player / coach signatures, team roster, and fee must be received by 2-23-24
- Teams are entered on a first come first serve basis with forms and fee in hand.

All games will be played at The Wexford Civic Center located on the corner of N Mitchell St. and 13th St. in Cadillac.

- * REGISTRATION DEADLINE ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN BY 2-23-24. Wexford Civic Center must have a copy of your USA Hockey or CAHA roster and entry fee by the deadline to be considered for tournament.
- ★ A cancelation fee of 50% of the tournament fee will be imposed for teams canceling within two weeks of the tournament start date.

<u>Acceptance:</u> All teams must be USA Hockey or CAHA registered. REGISTRATION DEADLINE - ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN by 02-23-24. Wexford Civic Center must have a copy of your USA Hockey or CAHA roster and entry fee by the deadline for tournament entry. USA Hockey roster is required to be in before first game!

<u>Games/Tournament Format:</u> Each team is guaranteed 4 games. Two divisions, "American" and "National" will divide 8 teams in to 2 divisions of 4 teams each. Each team will play round robin of 3 games in their respective division, which will establish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places in their division.

For the semi finals and championship games, the 1st place team in each division will crossover and play the 2nd place team in the opposite division in the semifinal. The 2 winners will play in the tournament championship game. The 3rd and 4th place teams in each division will cross over and play the team in the other division in their respective place in the standings. 3rd place in each division will play for 5th place and the 4th place teams will play for 7th place.

Running Clock and Mercy Rule: Any 7-goal differential constitutes a running clock. This will continue until the goal differential gets back within 7 goals. No curfew clock.

<u>Playing Rules:</u> All tournament games will be governed by MAHA, USA Hockey, and Cadillac Area Hockey Association rules. In addition, the following tournament rules apply.

- 1. Only those players registered with the tournament before the tournament begins are eligible to participate with their respective teams. Players cannot be added to rosters after tournament registration.
- 2. Proof of age must be brought with teams for checking by tournament officials prior to the first game. A team using ineligible players will be automatically disqualified. The tournament committee will take appropriate action it deems necessary to carry on the tournament.
- 3. Only players in complete uniform and the registered coaching staff (four registered coaches is the limit allowed) may be on the player's bench.
- 4. Teams should be ready to go on the ice 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time of the game.
- 5. Any major penalty for fighting will result in **automatic suspension** from the tournament.
- 6. Fans ejected during a game for verbally abusing referees, players or coaches are considered to be ejected for the remainder of the tournament.
- 7. The tournament committee/director reserves the right to make decisions regarding the interpretation of all tournament rules and all decisions are final.

Standings, Point System & Tie Breaking rules: Two points for a win, one point for a tie. In the event of a tie in record head to head will be used first. The second tiebreaker will be goal differential from all round robin games. Maximum goal differential for a game is 7. If still tied, preference shall be determined by the team who has scored the most goals in the all the games played to that point. If still tied, the team who has allowed the fewest goals against in all games played to that point gets preference. If still tied, the team that scored first in head to head takes the higher position.

Overtime Rules: Overtime will only be played in the semifinals and finals of the tournament. A 5 minute 4 on 4 sudden death OT period. If still tied, a 3 player shootout will occur. If the game is still tied, then a sudden death 1 player shootout will take place. Players who've already participated in the first round shootout will not be allowed to be selected to shoot again until all the players on the team (excluding the backup goalie) have gone through the first round. The championship game will be decided by 4 on 4 sudden death OT play until a team scores.
